General Information on PPT

Recognition of Prior Achievement (PPT) The Recognition of Prior Achievement (PPT) is a method to acknowledge individuals who can prove their prior experiences and achievements meet the competencies outlined in the National Occupational Skill Standard (NOSS). The implementation of the Malaysian Skills Certification through the PPT method was launched on 13 September 1996. It has provided skilled workers in the country with the opportunity to receive recognition for their existing skills and experiences.

What is the Purpose of PPT?

To provide recognition for the competencies acquired by individuals through formal or informal work experience and training, by awarding certifications such as SKM, DKM, or DLKM.

What Fields Can Be Certified Through PPT?

All fields listed in the National Occupational Skill Standard (NOSS) can be certified using this method, except for some specific areas.

Who Can Apply?

Open to individuals with skills and relevant work experience that meet the requirements outlined in the **Guidelines for the Implementation of Malaysian Skills Certification Through the PPT Method** and other conditions specified by NOSS. Applicants must also be able to provide valid evidence of their competencies.

How to Apply for Certification Through This Method?

Applications can be submitted at any time. Applicants need to conduct a self-assessment in the system to determine whether they meet the standard requirements for the desired program and evaluate their competencies. Additionally, they are required to upload the necessary documents as stipulated. Now we provide consulting service or workshop for Emergency Medical Technician Level 1,2, 3. Fire Rescue and Hazmat Operation.

What Are the Fees and Payment Methods?

The fee is based on the prevailing rates, which is currently RM800 depending on the application category.

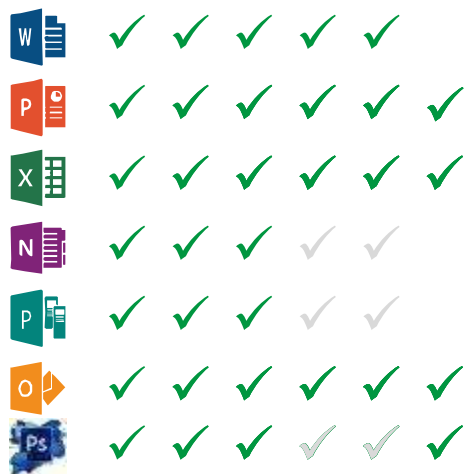

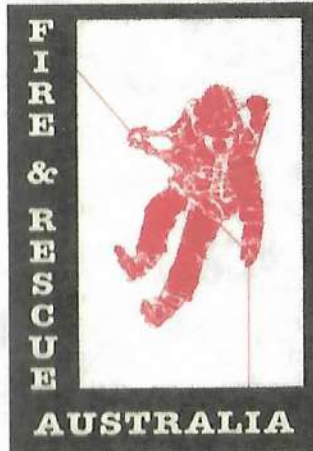

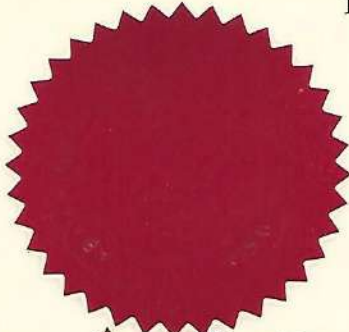
